 - a. There are 21 delegates with three at large
- III. Election Guidelines**
 - a. Sean Nauss, District Governor from Central Michigan University, entertains a motion to accept our election guidelines
 - b. Ben Strandskov, District Treasurer from Central Michigan University, moves the motion
 - c. Andrew Zyrowski, from Central Michigan University, seconded the motion
 - d. All in favor, the motion passes and the election guidelines are accepted
- IV. Standing Rules of the House**
 - a. Sean Nauss, District Governor from Central Michigan University, entertains a motion to accept the standing rules of the House of Delegates
 - b. Ben Strandskov, District Treasurer from Central Michigan University, moves the motion
 - c. Morgan Brown, from Western Michigan University, seconded the motion
 - d. All in favor, the motion passes and the standing rules of the House of Delegates are accepted
- V. Sean Nauss Announced that nominations, elections, and voting will take place at DCON**
- VI. Sean Nauss entertained a motion to block amendments 1-5**
 - a. Andrew Zyrowski moved the motion
 - b. Walter Whitt seconded the motion
 - c. All in favor, the motion passes and amendments 1-5 will be addressed as a block
- VII. Open Discussion**
 - a. Sean Nauss explained the purpose of the amendments
 - b. Discussions on the amendments took place
 - i. Ben Strandskov made a motion to remove amendment 3 from the block
 1. Walter Whitt seconds the motion

2. All in favor, the motion passes and amendment 3 will be voted on separately
- ii. Sean Nauss announces that we will move to a vote on the block including amendment 1, 2, 4, and 5.
 1. All in favor, the block passes
- iii. Ben Strandskov, from Central Michigan University, makes a motion to review amendment 3
 1. Morgan Brown seconds the motion
 2. All in favor, the motion passes and the delegates move to a discussion of amendment 3
 - a. A proposal is made to remove all but workshops for officer training, the friendly amendment is accepted by the executive board
 - i. Andrew Zyrowski, from Central Michigan University, proposes the amendment
 1. Walter Whitt seconds
 2. All in favor, the amendment passes
 - b. Jonathan Gavia, from University of Michigan Dearborn, moves to recall the previously moved motion
 - i. Ben Strandskov, from Central Michigan University, seconds
 - ii. All vote in favor and the motion passes
 - c. Jonathan Gavia, from University of Michigan Dearborn, motions to make line e. state that workshops for officer training are required and that the numbering of the following lines be fixed appropriately
 - i. Morgan Brown, from Western Michigan University, seconds the motion
 - ii. All in favor and the motion passes
 - d. Further discussion takes place and Sean Nauss states that will now move to a vote on the new amendment 3
 - i. The aye's have it, motion passes and amendment 3 is accepted
 - iv. Ben Strandskov, from Central Michigan University, makes a motion to adjourn the house of delegates
 1. Jonathan Gavia, from University of Michigan Dearborn, seconds the motion
 2. All in favor, the motion passes and house of delegates is adjourned
